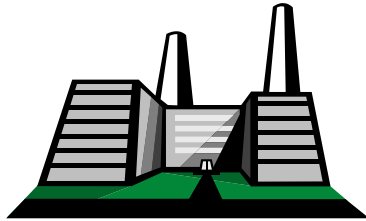

ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE IN MASSACHUSETTS



THE PROBLEM

Low income communities and communities of color bear a disproportionate share of our society's environmental burdens. Political and economic disempowerment often renders these communities voiceless in matters such as the siting of locally undesirable land uses and enforcement of environmental laws.

These communities may have little faith in the existing regime of environmental laws and policies. Further, the interests of low-income communities and communities of color have traditionally not received adequate attention from government environmental agencies or nonprofit environmental groups. This has merely increased the likelihood of disproportionate environmental harms.

WORKING TOWARDS A SOLUTION

The MEJAN is designed to help partner communities address pressing environmental and public health concerns. MEJAN professionals provide assistance to partner communities to prevent the siting of trash transfer facilities, preserve open space, reduce traffic and improve air quality.

In addition to helping partner communities achieve concrete victories, MEJAN's success is also measured by the empowerment of the communities that professionals work with — increasing residents' capacity to take control over decisions that affect their lives.
