ACE is a community based non-profit located in Dudley Square, Roxbury, MA. Our mission is to build the power of communities of color and low income communities in Massachusetts to eradicate environmental racism and classism, create healthy, sustainable communities, and achieve environmental justice. We believe everyone has the right to a healthy environment and to be decision-makers in issues affecting their communities.

ACE has four programs:

Environmental Justice Legal Services (EJLS) provides free legal assistance to community residents and groups throughout Massachusetts.

The **Roxbury Environmental Empowerment Project (REEP)** teaches youth to speak for themselves about issues that affect them most through youth internships and in-school programs.

The **T-Riders Union (TRU)** fights for transit equity through riders collectively demanding their right to first class public transit service.

The **Dudley Square Organizing Project (DSOP)** organizes Roxbury residents for equitable development and green justice.
